MPW Course

In the central area of the course room you can access the content of the course. It consists of several textbook chapters, e-cases and test questions.

We highly recommend that you first read one text book chapter, work then through the e-case(s) (where available), and complete then the chapter by answering the test questions.

Textbook chapter 1

The textbook chapters consist of various lessons. With the arrow keys on the right you can navigate from one lesson to another. You also can print the entire

chapter or individual lessons by using the settingsblock.

E-case

The problem-based e-learning cases present you a difficult real life situation. They contain sound and video material, for which you need a loudspeaker or headset. For being able to use the e-cases, a broad band internet connection is required, as well as the latest version of Adobe Flash Player (downloadable for free from the internet).

Test questions

For each test attempt a certain number of questions will randomly be selected. The test questions consist of single choice (one answer correct) and multiple choice questions (several answers correct). You will receive an immediate feedback after each test attempt, and you will be able to see the correct answers for a period of two minutes. Afterwards, only the reached points and an overall feedback will be visible. The tests are time-limited: you have about 1:30 minutes per question before submitting your answer. An attempt can be repeated at the earliest after 30 minutes; during this time, you should re-read the lesson(s) in which you failed. You have only three attempts to answer the tests of each chapter. In case of problems please contact the course facilitator(s) in the respective course.
